From John...Reflect

The word "reflect" comes from the Latin "to bend back." Light or images in a mirror are turned back toward the viewer. We use reflections to help us curate our physical appearance the way we want, making sure every hair is in place. We use reflection to help us identify how things are and start to shape them towards what they should be. We've also chosen to use the word reflect to describe a mode of contemplation. Like a mirror, we reflect, or look back, on the events of our lives to help us see what we need to change to be the people God wants us to be. In the hustle and bustle of Christmas, it's good to take some time to reflect on what God has done, and what He is calling us to do. Let this season be a time of reflection, but reflection that leads to change. As the book of James says: Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like a man who looks at his face in a mirror and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like. But the man who looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues to do this, not forgetting what he has heard, but doing it—he will be blessed in what he does. James 1:22-25


