From John ... "It's not hurting anyone"

This past weekend our men's group finished up the book, "The Men We Need," by Brant Hansen. One of the final points in the book was to expose the lie of "it's not hurting anyone." In reality, we tell ourselves this lie about all kinds of behaviors and practices that we want to excuse as being okay, even when we know they are wrong. Brant points out two reasons why this is a dangerous lie:

Even if an action doesn't directly affect someone else, it changes us, and eventually it will come out in some ways. Harboring a judgmental heart might seem to be an internal issue, but, if left to fester and grow, it will eventually come out in your words and actions to others.

Even with something that's not explicitly sinful, like simply vegging out all weekend binge-watching Netflix, when we spend our time in less productive ways, we are missing out on what we *could* be doing with our time. We could have volunteered, served, evangelized, read our Bibles, etc. While you might not have been actively hurting others, you are using your time in a way that prevents you from helping.

The "it's not hurting anyone" lie is pervasive and insidious in our culture. In what ways do you finding yourself buying into that lie, and what would God want you to change instead?


