Dietrich Bonhoeffer once wrote that grace is free, but it's not cheap. One can never buy the grace of Jesus, and yet it will cost everything we have. I am reminded of the story in Acts 19:19 where it says, "A number who had practiced sorcery brought their scrolls together and burned them publicly. When they calculated the value of the scrolls, the total came to fifty thousand drachmas." Calculating modern value of ancient money is surprisingly complicated, but this is upwards of \$250,000 in modern US currency. They didn't burn their scrolls to find salvation, but because they had found Jesus and decided that Jesus wanted them to get rid of their old, sinful ways.

What might Jesus be calling on you to sacrifice this week? What do you need to give up for the cause of Christ?
